Call for Nominations for the 2011 Medical Activist Award**

Annually, Women's Health Foundation hosts **Below the Belt: Fighting for Women's Pelvic Health**, a memorable evening which brings together the nation's most passionate champions of women's pelvic health side-by-side with the Chicagoland community in an intimate setting. The goal of the event is to raise money to support WHF's mission to advance women's pelvic health. **A centerpiece of the Below the Belt 2011 celebration, scheduled for June 4th, will be the announcement of the winner of the 2011 Medical Activist Award. For this award, we are asking industry leaders and WHF partners for input, suggestions and nominations.**

The WHF Medical Activist Award is given to a healthcare professional that has broken down barriers, changed medical practice, added to science or otherwise shown outstanding dedication and innovation in women's pelvic medicine.

The 2010 Medical Activist Award winner was Dr. Roger Goldberg, the Clinical Assistant Professor at the University of Chicago Pritzker School of Medicine, and Director of Research at NorthShore University HealthSystem. The 2009 Medical Activist Award was presented to Dr. Leslee Subak, University of California, San Francisco Associate Professor in the Departments of Obstetrics, Gynecology & Reproductive Sciences, Urology and Epidemiology and Biostatistics. In 2008, Dr. Linda Brubaker, Chief and Fellowship Director of the Division of Urogynecology and Reconstructive Pelvic Surgery at Loyola University Medical Center, received the Medical Activist Award.
